On January 12th of this year, few would have missed the news that a huge earthquake had flattened much of Port-Au-Prince, the capital city of Haiti. We were shocked and moved to hear of the devastation to so many lives caused by one of the worst natural disasters of all time. The poorest nation in the western hemisphere, suddenly had to totally rebuild not only its capital, but much of the surrounding area as well - but with what?

2010 is YWAM International's 50th anniversary. It's our **Jubilee** year - a year, we believe, of God's favour. The Jubilee year is all about re-setting and starting over. It's about declaring afresh that our trust is in God alone, and not in the blessings He has allowed us to amass. It's about a divinely inspired re-distribution of wealth, ensuring the rich

don't get too rich, and the poor don't get too poor.

From the beginning we felt the Lord compelling us to go to Haiti. We wanted to enter into the spirit of jubilee by sending a team from YWAM Singapore, coming from this blessed, first world nation, to go and serve the poorest of the poor.

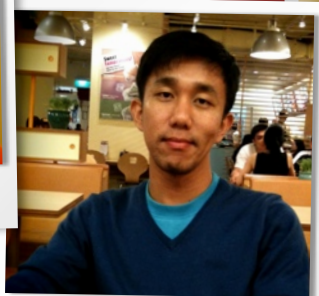
